The Grand Canyon is located in northwest Arizona. This spectacular canyon is a deep gorge cut into the earth by the Colorado River millions of years ago. The canyon winds for almost 220 miles, ranges 4 to 14 miles wide, and is up to one mile deep.

Over 4 million tourists visit Grand Canyon National Park every year. Raft trips down the Colorado River are a popular way of experiencing the canyon. Small and large raft groups ride down the Colorado River, led by experienced tour guides. The ride is peaceful and quiet as the rafts glide through the breathtaking scenery, with ongoing lectures on the history of the canyon, rock formations, the wildlife and river. The guides warn of the approach to the rapids.
